Seven Air-Conditioned Spaces Open to the Public | Protection Measures for Workers, Vulnerable Groups, and Stray Animals

The City of Athens is placing all its services on full operational readiness due to the very high temperatures expected over the coming days. In accordance with the Municipality's Civil Protection plan, starting tomorrow, July 20, and for as long as necessary, seven Municipal Friendship Clubs (Lesches Filias) will operate from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as air-conditioned spaces for the public.

Specifically for the high-temperature days, KYADA (Reception and Solidarity Center of the City of Athens) will supply the Friendship Clubs, the Multipurpose Homeless Center, and the Day Center with water, beverages, and special protection kits.

Increased Operational Readiness

The City of Athens will be on high alert. Specifically:

- Teams from the Cleaning and Greenery Directorates are on 24-hour standby, conducting patrols.
- The Municipal Police is monitoring parks and high-risk areas using ground units and camera-equipped drones for the immediate detection of critical temperature fluctuations.
- Municipal water tankers remain on continuous standby.
- The Civil Protection Contractor Registry is activated, deploying three fire engines equipped with water cannons. Two vehicles are positioned at the Municipal Children's Camps in Agios Andreas, Attica, and one at Mount Lycabettus.
- The Municipal Police Operations Center operates 24/7 in coordination with the Fire Brigade, relevant authorities, and other municipal services as needed.
